Sanctuary Renovation Update

- Received Commitment Letter from Atlantic Union Bank.
 - By June 15, we expect to pay out:
 - Southern Air - \$150,877
 - Demolition Services - \$88,000
 - Dex Sanders (architect) – TBD
 - Permit Fees - TBD
- 1st Floor Demolition is substantially completed.

Sanctuary Renovation Update

- Pews have been removed.
- Flooring, electrical, drywall will go out to bid soon.
- Plan to cover HVAC holes in sanctuary floor in next 2 weeks.
- Hope to start painting the sanctuary the week of June 12.
- Hope to order chairs week of June 5. (we have 400 chairs that we can use temporarily)
- Likely out of the sanctuary from June 12 to mid-July.

Leading Financially

- Would like to have “first checks” in from all leadership by June 5 service.
- We need to show our “right now” and ongoing commitment to this project.
- Honor system – no one is going to call or print names.

What's growing?

- Senior Adults – continue to be the growing demographic in Culpeper.
 - Concert series
 - The Arbors & The Culpeper
- Youth Ministry
- Young Adult Ministry
- Child Development Center
 - Family Nights/Parents Night Out/Shared activities

How does growth influence worship services?

- Experiment with both models – October - December?
- IF we stay in 2 services, we are in the same space/"traffic pattern."
- Growth potential of 2 services vs. 1 service
- One service is "easier" and provides more opportunities to restart Sunday- focused groups.
- Continue to add non-Sunday services
- Could we outgrow 1 service in 2-4 years?
 - We currently average 210 in worship from an attendance base of 350ish.
- Regular rhythms of shared services.
 - 2024 – year long celebration of our 250th.



October-November

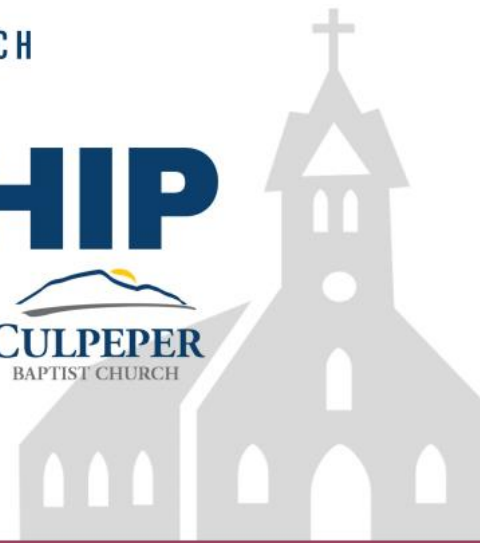
- 2 services in Sanctuary (9:00 a.m. & 10:30 a.m.)
