1. The Power of Words in Our Witness

Peter's witness at Pentecost changed thousands of lives. Words have power.

- How do the words we use reflect our faith in Christ?
- Can you think of a time when someone's words encouraged or discouraged your faith?
- How can we be intentional about using words that build others up and point them to Christ?

2. Love and Inclusiveness in Witnessing

The Pentecost event welcomed people from different backgrounds and cultures into the faith.

- How does the inclusiveness of the early church challenge us today?
- What are some practical ways we can show love and respect to people of different backgrounds?
- How does the phrase, "We serve not to convert but because we are converted," reshape our approach to witnessing?

3. Commitment to the Church

The early disciples devoted themselves to teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, and prayer.

- Why is being an active part of a church community essential to our witness?
- How have you personally experienced growth in your faith through the local church?
- In what ways can we encourage greater involvement and commitment in our church today?

4. Trusting God in Our Witness

Peter stood up and witnessed without knowing how people would respond.

- What fears or hesitations do we have when sharing our faith?
- How can we overcome these fears and trust that God will work through us?
- Have you ever shared your story with someone? What was the experience like?
