1. Devotion to Teaching

- What role does sharing meals play in building a faith community?
- What barriers prevent us from hospitality, and how can we overcome them?

4. Commitment to Prayer & Worship

"Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts."

- Why is corporate worship important for discipleship?
- In what ways can we integrate our faith more into our daily public lives?
