4. What tends to get in the way of experiencing real transformation through worship?

5. How do you handle it when you leave a mountaintop worship experience and walk into a “valley” of ordinary or even messy life?
6. What helps you carry the glory of God's presence back into your everyday life?

Reflecting God's Glory:

7. Paul says in 2 Corinthians 3:16-18 that when we turn to the Lord, the veil is lifted, and we are transformed.
 - What does it mean for you to have an “unveiled” face in your life today?
