Discussion Questions

1. The Power of Storytelling in Worship

- Why does Peter use Joel's prophecy to explain what's happening?
- How does connecting worship to God's past actions shape our present experience of Him?

2. Worship That Includes Everyone

- Joel speaks of sons, daughters, old, young, men, and women all receiving the Spirit.
- What does this reveal about God's desire for inclusion?
- Who might feel excluded in our worship settings? What can we do about it?

3. From Consumer to Participant

- The sermon warns against approaching worship as consumers.
- What does it mean to truly participate in worship?

4. Worship Across Generations

- The message challenges both older and younger believers to listen and learn from each other.
- How can we bridge generational and stylistic gaps in worship?

5. The Spirit Still Moves

- At Pentecost, the Spirit enabled people to speak in others' languages.
- What does it look like today to "speak the worship language" of people different from us?
