Discussion Questions

1. What stands out to you about how this hymn describes Jesus?
2. Verse 17 says, *"In him all things hold together."* How do you see this truth in your own life or in the world?
3. How does this hymn connect Jesus to the creation story in Genesis 1?
4. Why would this hymn be especially powerful for Christians living under Roman rule in the first century?
5. What does it mean for Christ to be "head of the church" in practical terms for us today?
6. If Christ is reconciling all things, what does that mean for our relationships, communities, and even creation itself?
7. How can our worship—both music and lifestyle—become a witness to Christ's reconciling work?
8. In what ways have songs of faith (hymns, worship songs, or spiritual songs) helped you experience God's presence or truth more deeply?

What part of your life do you need to entrust to Christ instead of holding together on your own?

How might God be calling you to join in His reconciling work this week?
