Sermon Discussion Guide - The Song of Creation - Genesis 1 & 2

What's one thing in creation that brings you joy or wonder?

Genesis 1 & 2 helps us answer the question - Where do we come from?

What stands out to you about the repeated phrase "And God saw that it was good"?

• How does it change your view of God to know He notices and delights in details of creation, including you?

What does the creation story tell us about God's character—His love, creativity, and purpose?

The sermon suggested that Genesis 1 is a hymn, a song of praise. How do you think singing—or praising—God helps us respond to creation?

Do you tend to approach God's creation technically (like blueprints) or poetically (like a story)? How might seeing both perspectives deepen our worship?

We are made in the image of God (Imago Dei). What aspects of God do you see reflected in yourself or in others?

How does knowing that you come from a God of blessing and goodness shape the way you view yourself and the world?

God's rest is described as holy. How do you practice rest in your life? What might it mean to dwell with God in His creation?

How does the idea of God dwelling with us change your understanding of His relationship with the world and with you personally?

How can we live in a way that reflects the goodness, blessing, and creativity of God in our daily lives?

How could our small group, community, or family "sing" the song of creation through words, actions, or service this week?
